

YESHIVAS MAHARIT D'SATMAR

GROUNDNS FOR DISMISSAL

Students who do not adhere to Yeshivas Maharit D'Satmar's academic standards or standards of conduct, including a serious breach of character or moral conduct as defined by the Shulchan Aruch, may be considered for dismissal. It should be noted dismissals are extremely rare in the institution as every effort is made initially to admit students of the highest character and academic standing.

Any student dismissed from Yeshivas Maharit D'Satmar will not be permitted to register for any additional courses. The student may however submit a formal appeal of the decision to the Administrator of the Yeshiva. In the event the student is re-admitted, he will be placed on probation for one semester, during which time he must satisfy any conditions specified in his re-instatement.
